CONTEST RULES:

- Artwork may be no larger than 11" x 14" (including mat). No framed or 3D art will be accepted.
- The theme "Dreams on the Prairie" applies for judging to ages 11 and younger. Students aged 12 and older may choose to use the theme, but it is not required.
- Only one entry per child. There are five **AGE** categories: Age 5-6, 7-9, 10-11, 12-14 and 15-18
- Artwork should be dropped off at the Piedmont Public Library during regular operating hours from August 31st, through September 9th at 5pm.
- The deadline for entry is Wednesday, September 9th at 5pm. No artwork will be accepted for judging later than this date and time.
- Winners in each age category will receive a Michaels gift card.
- Artwork will be displayed at the First Baptist Church on Founder's Day, and should be picked up at 3pm that day.
- Artwork not picked up on Founder's Day should be picked up at the Piedmont Public Library by noon on September 18th, or it will become property of PLACES.

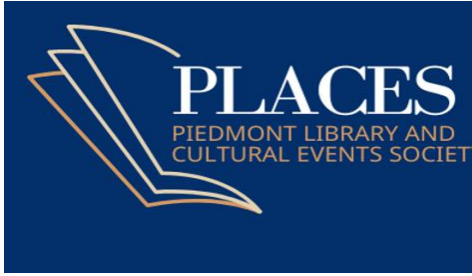
